The Tazewell County Electoral Board met in the General Registrar's office Monday, November 13, 2017 for the purpose of concluding the canvass of votes obtained during the November 7th General Election.

The meeting was called to order by Chair, Emma Hagy at 12:00pm. In attendance were Beth Grindstaff, Vice Chair, Sherman Cain, Secretary, Brian Earls, Director of Elections and Alicia Kitts, Deputy Registrar. No one was present in the public gallery.

Director Earls declared the voters we were waiting on had not appeared nor otherwise produced any qualifying identification documentation in advance of the 12 noon November 13, 2017 deadline. The Board therefore could not consider the ballots.

The Board heard from Brian Earls and Alicia Kitts further recapping the November 7 election whereby general discussions of minor complications and issue items ensued. The Board agreed everything went well and the new voting equipment was well received by the public.

The Board thanked Director of Elections, Brian Earls, Deputy Registrar, Alicia Kitts and the entire registrar staff for their stellar performance during the 2017 election season. The Board specifically commended Brian Earls and Alicia Kitts for their excellent work, dedication and passion during the accelerated pace of change brought on by the acquisition of and transition from the old voting equipment to the new.

There being no further business Sherman Cain moved that the meeting of the Electoral Board of Tazewell County be adjourned, seconded by Beth Grindstaff; unanimously carried. The meeting was adjourned at 1:15pm.
